
Setting up your phone

Your phone already has a SIM card installed.


Optional: Insert the microSD card

Step 1. Open the SIM/microSD card slot

With the phone facing down, open the card slot cover.



Step 2. Pull out the SIM/microSD card tray Hook your fingernail on the rib on the tray's top edge and pull it out.




NOTE: microSD cards are sold separately.

Step 3. Place a microSD card

Put the tray onto a flat surface and place a microSD card into the tray with the gold contacts facing down as shown.

a. Slightly push it at a 30 to 45 degree angle to a resin spring.



b. Place it down to the tray while pushing it to the resin spring.



Step 4. Insert the SIM/microSD card trav

Insert the tray into the phone, being careful not to let the cards slide out. Then gently push the tray in until it clicks.



Step 5. Close the SIM/microSD card slot

After the tray is all the way back in your phone, securely close the card slot cover.



NOTE: Make sure the SIM/microSD card slot cover is securely closed to maintain your phone's waterproof

WARNING: Do not use the phone under water with a broken or open SIM/microSD slot cover, USB/Charger port cover or headset jack cover.



Step 6. Charge your phone

Before turning on your phone, charge it fully.

NOTE: Use only a USB Type-C charger/cable for this phone.

Open the USB/Charger port cover and insert the small end of the USB cable into the phone. Insert the larger end into the charger and plug it into an outlet.



When charging is complete, remove the cable from the port and securely close the cover.

Turning your phone on

To turn your phone on, press and hold the Power button.

Turning your phone off

- 1 Press and hold the **Power** button until the phone options are displayed.
- 2. Tap Power off to turn the phone off.

Locking/unlocking the screen

To turn on your screen, press the **Power** button Then-



Swipe up to open the Home screen.



Swipe left to open the Camera app.



Swipe right to launch Google

To turn off your screen and prevent accidental key presses, press the **Power** button.

- 1. From the Home screen, tap an app icon that you want to open.

- 1. Swipe up from the bottom of the Home screen to open the Apps launcher screen.
- 2. Tap an app icon that you want to open.

Using the dialpad:

- 1. From the Home screen, tap 🕎 to open the phone app.
- 2. Tap **DIALPAD** to display the dialpad.
- 3. Tap the number keys on the dialpad to enter the phone number.
- 4. Tap \(\mathbb{\cappa} \) to call the number.
- 5. To end the call, tap ...

From Contacts list:

- 1. From the Home screen, tap (19).
- 2. Tap **CONTACTS** to display your contacts list
- 3. Tap the contact you want to call.
- 4. Tap \ to call the number.
