

How to replace the SIM Install a SIM/ microSD

1. Remove the battery cover and the battery.

2. Lift the SIM/microSD guard tab by its edge until it stands up; then grip and pull the tab to flip open the guard.



3. Push the SIM card gently with your finger and then release the pressure to take out the original SIM card. Insert the new SIM card carefully until it snaps into place.







- 4. Slide the microSD card into the slot with the gold contacts facing down if necessary.
- 5. Place back the SIM/microSD guard and battery, and then close the battery cover firmly.

Turn on your new phone

Press and hold the END/POWER key until the screen lights up.

To turn your phone off, press and hold the END/POWER key until you see the powering-down animation on the main screen.

Call Family & Friends Make a Call

- 1. Open the phone and enter a phone number.
- 2. Press the Center soft key **[Call]** or SEND key.
